As the month of March is fast approaching, I would like to take the opportunity to notify you of some upcoming events and new initiatives in our school;

<u>Confirmation</u>; We also look forward to celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation in St. Mary's Cathedral on Friday March 8th at 2.30pm.

<u>Service of light;</u> The Service of light for 6th class pupils will take place in the school on Tuesday, March 5th at 2pm. Parents are welcome to attend.

<u>Enrolment 2024</u>; Applications for our Junior Infant class 2024 are now closing. Application forms are available to download from our website or directly from the office. The closing date is tomorrow, February 23rd 2024.
